#### **Item 5.02 Departure of Directors or Principal Officers; Election of Directors; Appointment of Principal Officers.**

Election of Director – On May 9, 2006, the Executive Committee, acting under its delegated responsibility as the nominating committee, made a recommendation to elect, Walter B. Hurley, Jr. to fill the vacancy on the Board created by the death of his father, Walter B. Hurley, Sr. Mr. Hurley, Jr. has been the primary operating manager of his father's companies, Bethpage Camp Resort in Urbanna, Virginia, Grey's Point Camp in Topping, Virginia, and Hurlock Management in Urbanna, Virginia. His business expertise and familiarity with banking and commercial financial issues made him an able replacement. The Executive Committee also felt it necessary to maintain a presence and be visible to residents of Middlesex County. After due consideration and discussion, the Board unanimously approved the election of Walter B. Hurley, Jr. to serve on the Board of Directors. Mr. Hurley accepted the position and began his service with the meeting of June 13, 2006.
